The inaugural CIS Local Counsel Forum was held in Kiev in June 2006, hosted by RULG-Ukrainian Legaroup, and was the first ever wide-scale meeting of the international legal community with the best Lo Counsel law firms from the CIS economic region (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhsta Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan). Since then, the C Forum has evolved into an informal network of managing and senior partners of CIS and international I firms, meeting annually in different venues chosen by the Delegates.

The Forum meetings bring together leading business lawyers from the CIS economic region and from around the world, with an approximately equal split between representatives of the international lead community and of the CIS legal community. The Delegates share the Mission of the Forum – "Bringi together the CIS and international legal communities with the aim of creating joint business opportunit and long-term cooperation". This Mission reflects the 21st century reality, in which global investors view to CIS countries as a broad and dynamic economic region with intertwined business connections a comparable legal systems. The motto of the Forum is "Know Your Local Counsel – Recognize Opportunity".

The Forum allows the Delegates to share, in an open and friendly spirit, the latest legal and economic ne from their jurisdictions, and to establish important business contacts. The Forum meetings – first in Kiev 2006, second in Baku in 2007, third in St. Petersburg in 2008, and fourth in Kiev in 2009 – demonstrat

the huge demand among CIS law firms for on-going communication and business cooperation, as well the international legal community's serious interest in the CIS region. Although the economic crisis haffected the CIS region as much as the rest of the world, we have to withstand the crisis as a community our best efforts will be rewarded with new contacts, ideas, projects and alliances, just as at all previce Forums.

The Forum's success is explained by the outstanding value it gives to the Delegates, in equal measures both law firms and corporate counsel.
